

This is the Mustang Estate Wagon. It was a prototype that Ford made sometime in the mid-60s.



UNCOMMON MUSTANG is this station wagon conversion commissioned by adman Barney Clark and designer Bob Cumberford of New York. Intermeccanica of Italy performed the actual reconstruction, moving the rear of the hardtop back to the rear and installing a longer roof section and swing-out side windows. With fuel filler located in the rear quarter, lower rear panel could be adapted into a swing-down tailgate to complete the station wagon idiom.
